4. Competitions

Sportshall – 2019 dates; 19th Oct Norwich, 11th Nov King's Lynn, 30th Nov Norwich. Entries for the County Champs down at the moment and need a final push. Regional Champs on 9th Feb at Sportspark, officials needed.
